All Saints Episcopal Church is renting space in our building and their congregation worships in the sanctuary at 10:30 am each Sunday. Our website features a shared online calendar of events.

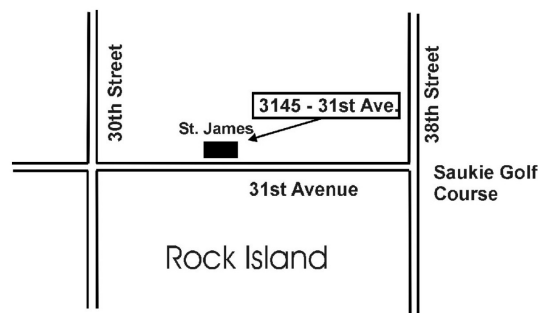
